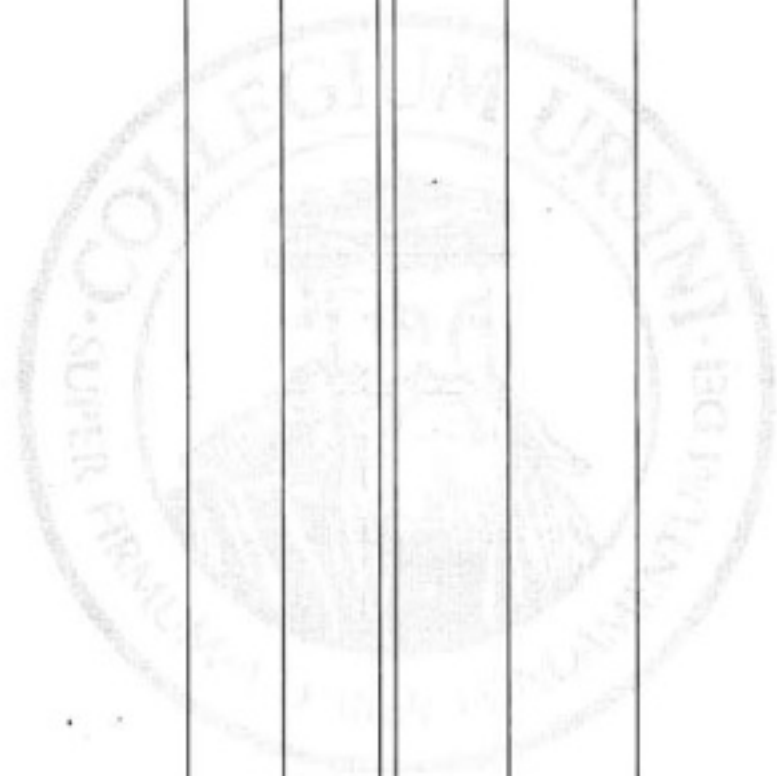

## EXPLANATION OF TRANSCRIPT

The academic year at Ursinus College consists of two semesters of approximately fifteen weeks each. The College also offers summer sessions in the day and evening. A minimum of 122 credits (120 credits in Evening Division) is required for graduation for students entering prior to June, 1990. Students entering in or after June, 1990 are required to complete a minimum of 128 credits for graduation. A GPA of C (2.00) or above for all courses taken at Ursinus is also required for graduation. The Ursinus College Evening Division offers associate degrees, which require 64 credits, and a post-baccalaureate certificate of professional studies (CAPS), which requires 30-33 credits, depending on the concentration.

### Course Numbering System

The system used in numbering courses reflects in general the year of college in which many students schedule a course. Thus a course taken normally in the first year will begin with the number 1, in the second year with a 2 and so on. Numbers do not indicate the year in which a course must or should be taken.

In designating courses of study, odd numerals generally are employed to indicate the courses normally offered during the fall term and even numerals, the work of the spring term. Courses whose numbers are followed by a "W" are writing-intensive courses. Courses whose numbers are followed by a "Q" are those which involve quantitative analysis.

### Grading System

When a course has been completed, the standing of the student is expressed by one of the following grades: A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D, D-, F. Letter grades have the following equivalence assigned:

The mark of W signifies that a student withdrew from the course prior to the mid-point of a course, and is not calculated into a student's average. The mark of WF signifies that a student withdrew from the course after the mid-point of the course, and is calculated into the student's average as an F (0.00).

The mark of I, which may be given only with the written permission of the dean, is reserved for cases of incomplete work, due to documented physical incapacitation or other extenuating circumstances beyond the student's control. If the mark of I is not removed within one month after the end of the semester in which the I was given, the grade of F will be assigned for the course.

Students who matriculated in or after June, 1988 may retake any course, but they shall receive credits only once for the same course. Although a course may be retaken as many times as necessary to receive a passing grade, students may repeat only once courses they passed on the initial try. All grades for courses taken at Ursinus will appear on the transcript, but the last grade earned will replace the previous grades for the purpose of calculating the GPA. The repeat course will be indicated with an R after the course number. Credits earned elsewhere and accepted as transfer credits will not alter the GPA or serve as a replacement grade.
